- Lead weekly calls with 3PL partners to track open actions, process improvement, KPI management, and distribution project management
- Work with Global Supply Planners to reconcile inventory discrepancies
- Monitor and control Warehouse cycle counts and execute required adjustments as necessary
- Develop and deploy Transportation/Distribution KPI's to ensure data driven decision making and supplier accountability
- Develop process flow documents and SOP's to ensure consistent execution of distribution practices
- Ability to leverage and interpret data into business intelligence
