RESPONSIBILITIES

- Read procedures and following instructions to comprehend the quality expectations for the product and supplies
- Understand product details and drawings
- Maintain and use all equipment to conduct test for product
- Approve or reject materials with respect to quality standards and record performance on tracking sheets
- Select output samples and check them using appropriate methods (measuring dimensions, recognizing, and categorizing defects, comparing to specifications etc.)
- Use automated systems to perform complex testing procedures
- Maintain records of testing, information, and various metrics such as number of defective types and products per batch/day etc. record in database when appropriate
- Complete and store all Batch traceability files
- Inspect procedures of the entire production cycle to ensure they are efficient and comply with safety standards
- Monitor the use of equipment to ensure it is safe and well-maintained and discard any that doesn't meet requirements
- Order and receive supplies necessary to complete task and maintain room upkeep
- Prepare and submit reports to the production manager
- Other duties as assigned
