How to Check the Natlex website for Legislation Updates

- 1. Click on the following link to access the Natlex database: <u>http://www.ilo.org/dyn/natlex/natlex4.home?p_lang=en</u>
- 2. You are now viewing the Natlex database.

We recommend checking the Natlex database at the beginning of each month for the previous calendar month as this will ensure you have captured all updates. For example, if the date today is the 15th May, you will need to select the month of **`April'** from the drop down list as May is still in progress and more updates might yet appear.



3. Once you have selected the relevant month from the list, you will see a list of countries appear, similar to the below image. If a country does not appear in the list, it means there have been no legislation changes for that country under the month selected.

You will also see a number in brackets next to the country, this number indicates how many important additions have been recorded for that country during the selected month.

4. Click on the country you wish to investigate further and it will present you with all the legislation changes recorded for that month.

Once you have clicked on the country, the legislation updates will appear in a list similar to below.



You can then read through all updates to ensure you are compliant with the legislation changes recorded in the database.
